



Attached is the list of clubs being offered for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester for students in 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade. Please read the descriptions below for any important information prior to signing up.

**Student selection for clubs will be a lottery. All club sign-up sheets are due on Friday, August 30. Students names will be chosen randomly and you will receive club confirmation on Friday, September 6. Clubs start the week of September 9, 2019.**

We invite all GSA students (1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>) to take part in the clubs that we are offering! Clubs will run on **Monday, Tuesday and Thursday** from **3:25-3:55**. Students are to be **picked up promptly at the end of clubs (3:55)**. **Students not picked up by 4:05 will be sent to Aftercare at the expense of the parents.**

If your child is in need of tutoring, you will receive a note from the classroom teacher. Tutoring takes place at the same time as clubs. Therefore, some students may need to wait until the next session to join clubs.

**Please know that clubs are a privilege. If a student receives discipline referrals, failing grades or is chronically absent/tardy or missing assignments, they will not be able to participate in clubs until grades, behavior, assignments and attendance improves. Students who miss 3 days of clubs will be removed from said club.**

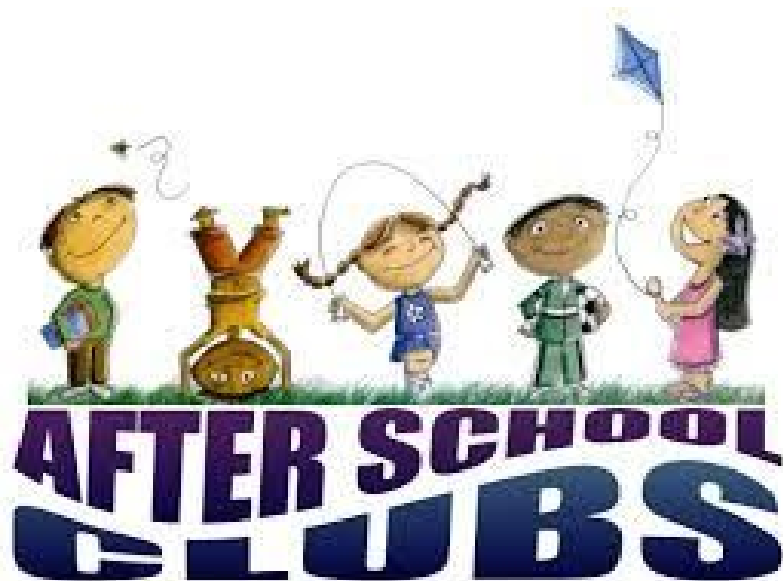
Students will practice for math contest and cover some middle school topics.
