



Attached is the list of clubs being offered for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester for students in Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup> grade. Please review the list, **making note of the grade range**, to see what your child is interested in. Students will be placed in one club each semester. Please read the descriptions below for any important information prior to signing up.

**Student selection for clubs will be a lottery. All club sign-up sheets are due Wednesday, January 8. Student names will be chosen randomly and you will receive club confirmation on Friday, January 10. Clubs start the week of January 13, 2020.**

We invite all GSA students (Kindergarten-5<sup>th</sup>) to take part in the clubs that we are offering! Clubs will run on **Monday and Thursday from 3:25-3:55. THE ONLY CLUBS OFFERED ON TUESDAY ARE ROBOTICS AND GOTR.** Students are to be **picked up promptly at the end of clubs (3:55). Students not picked up by 4:05 will be sent to Aftercare at the expense of the parents.**

Tutoring is the focus for Tuesdays and some additional tutoring will also be offered on Mondays and Thursdays. Tutoring times are the same as clubs – 3:25-3:55. Your child's teacher will confirm tutoring recommendations with you.

**Please know that clubs are a privilege. If a student receives discipline referrals, failing grades or is chronically absent/tardy or has missing assignments, they will not be able to participate in clubs until grades, behavior, assignments and attendance improves. Students who miss 3 days of clubs will be removed from said club.**
